He taught poetics and poetry at the University of British Columbia for over thirty years, and is the author of *Stubborn Poetries: Poetic Facticity and the Avant-Garde* (2013) and editor of *The Collected Poems and Plays of Robert Duncan* (published in two volumes in 2012 and 2013). He runs Nomados Literary Publishers with his wife, Meredith.
