The event was attended by poets from around the world, including Canadians Michael Ondaatje, Steve McCaffery, Phyllis Webb, George Bowering, Fred Wah, and Daphne Marlatt; and a number of Americans, including Michael Palmer, Charles Bernstein and Norma Cole.
