Flutist Robert Aitken, of Toronto, who is a visiting associate in the Centre for Communications and the Arts at SFU this summer, will be featured in two CBC Concerts this week. On Wednesday, July 27, at 10.30 p. m. he will perform with the distinguished Canadian harpsichordist, Greta Kraus; the program will include the Suite for Flute and Continuo, Op. 11, No. 4 by Jacques Hotteterre and the Concerto No. 1 for Flute and Harpsichord in D Major by Telemann. On Sunday, July 31, at 11.03 a. m. he will be soloist with the CBC Vancouver Chamber Orchestra in the Poem by Griffes and in the Ballade for flute, piano and strings by Martin.
